MUSIC believes that the pressure to eliminate lead and other hazardous substances in electronic interconnections will eventually become a major industry requirement.

MUSIC began to develop its lead-free “green” package qualification program in 2002 in conjunction with industry partners and is now happy to confirm to all interested customers that it is able to support a growing demand for its products in packages that fully conform with the provisions of EU Directive 2002/95/EC on the Restriction on Hazardous Substances (RoHS).

Notwithstanding this, MUSIC wishes to assure its valuable customers that it will continue to fully support customer demand for its products in their **existing packages**, until that demand no longer exists.

Qualified samples of lead free “green” package products are available on request. For ordering purposes lead free “green” package products utilize the same part number as the current products with the exception of an “F” at the end of the part number.

We anticipate, at least for the foreseeable future, that pricing for current product and lead-free “green” package product will be identical.
